# **Scholarships by Destination Country**

#### **United States**

#### Fulbright Foreign Student Program

- Award Amount: Varies (typically covers tuition, living expenses, health insurance, and travel)

# **How to Apply for Scholarships**

## **General Tips for Scholarship Applications**

- 1. Start Early: Begin your search and application process at least 12 months before your intended study date.
- 2. Check Eligibility: Carefully review all eligibility requirements before investing time in applications.
- 3. Prepare Documents: Common documents required include:
  - Academic transcripts and certificates
  - Standardized test scores (TOEFL/IELTS, GRE/GMAT)
  - Curriculum Vitae/Resume
  - Statement of Purpose/Personal Statement
  - Research proposal (for research degrees)
  - Letters of recommendation
  - Proof of financial need (for need-based scholarships)

- 4. Craft Compelling Essays: Tailor your personal statements to each scholarship, highlighting relevant experiences and future goals.
- 5. Request Strong Recommendations: Choose recommenders who know you well and can speak specifically about your achievements.
- 6. Meet Deadlines: Create a calendar with all application deadlines and prepare submissions well in advance.
- 7. Follow Instructions: Pay careful attention to formatting, word limits, and submission requirements.

## **Scholarship Application Timeline**

#### 12-18 months before study:

- Research scholarship opportunities
- Take required standardized tests
- Begin networking with potential recommenders

#### 9-12 months before study:

- Request official transcripts and test scores
- Draft personal statements and essays
- Approach potential recommenders

#### 6-9 months before study:

- Submit scholarship applications with early deadlines
- Refine application materials for upcoming deadlines
- Follow up with recommenders

#### 3-6 months before study:

- Submit remaining scholarship applications
- Follow up on submitted applications
- Prepare for potential interviews

#### After receiving decisions:

- Notify scholarship providers of other funding received
- Complete any required acceptance procedures
- Fulfill any pre-departure requirements
